Students are also required to submit a detailed resume and an essay. All materials must be postmarked no later than **February 28, 2010**.

- High school diploma or no more than 9 credit hours of post-secondary education
- Enrolled in or planning to enroll in the Ottatown program
- Current and/or recent past leadership involvement (for more information on this please review the Detailed Resume section or contact your Admission Counsellor)

**Please submit a detailed resume**, include the following areas of involvement as they relate to your area of leadership and achievement, starting only from your grade nine year. Some areas may not apply to you.

- Award(s) received in your education (e.g. honour roll recognition, prizes)
- School leadership activities, club and/ or organization involvement and areas of volunteer involvement (i.e. member of the Drama Club, member of the Yearbook Committee, etc)
- Church leadership activities or areas of church involvement
- School activities and/or outside of school volunteer involvement
- In sports, any individual awards/recognition, and/or team successes?
- Instruments played, and music involvements such as band, choirs, orchestra, musicals, etc.
- Abilities and interests (such as hobbies, music, sports, passions)
- Any paid work experience
- Camp involvement

**Please submit a 1000 word essay (roughly 4 pages double spaced).** In this essay tell us about a leader who inspired you, what you learned from that leader and the qualities you want to emulate. Describe your most meaningful leadership achievements. What inspires and motivates you to lead, achieve, and serve others. How does your faith relate to what you do? Finally, reflect on qualities of leadership that you want to develop while on Ottatown and beyond.

**Please submit two Letters of Nomination.** There is a separate **Ottatown Leadership Nomination** Form. Please give this nomination form to the two people who you would like to give reasons as to why you should be considered for an Ottatown Leadership Scholarship.
